

GLOSSARY OF TERMS USED

Community group – an organised group of individuals in the community, meeting on a regular basis around a shared interest or activity.

Mapping – producing a list of all that goes on in the community. This can include information about community group activities, doctor surgeries, shops and parks.

Consultation – to ask questions about the local community, recording the answers of local people, groups, organisations and businesses. The answers, when asked of enough people and combined

Community Profile – to add some history and information to ‘Mapping’, including the community’s

MUGA – Multi Use Games Area. Generally an artificially surfaced outdoor games court which can accommodate a variety of sports depending on its dimensions.

SMAT – Substance Misuse Action Team. This is a multi-agency partnership that is a sub-group of the Safer Swansea Partnership, which commissions and delivers drug and alcohol treatment services and projects from the health and voluntary sectors. The SMAT also seeks to reduce substance misuse related crime and disorder in our communities.
